Live in Peace

This pattern is designed to ease the pain of waiting our Jyväskylä Summer Knit Festival! Prefestshawl has been released every year before the festival from different designers and it's been lovely to see many of them in the crowd during the festival.

Live in Peace

Materials

Tukuwool Fingering **color A** raku 100 g, **color B** humu 150 g
Filcolana Tilia 25 g, **color C** mustard
Needles 4 mm

Gauge 18 s x 38 rows

Finished measurements after blocking: width 35 cm, length 240 cm without tassels

NOTE! Slip the last st on each row purlwise with yarn in front of the work and knit the first st on each row.

Stripe sequence throughout the shawl, except the wide panel with silkmohair bobbles:

Color A Tukuwool Fingering raku: 18 rows = 9 purl ridges

Color C Tilia mustard: 4 rows = 2 purl ridges

Color B Tukuwool Fingering humu: 18 rows = 9 purl ridges

Color C Tilia mustard: 4 rows = 2 purl ridges

Bobble using silk mohair

K1, yo, k1, yo, k1. [Turn work. K5], repeat [-] 2 more times. Turn work. Knit 5 sts together. If you do the last row of bobble a bit looser, it's easier to work the knit 5 together and stitches won't be too tight.

Instructions

Starting triangle, increases

Row 1 (RS): CO 3 sts with color A.

Row 2 (WS): Knit 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif.

Row 3: Kfb x 2, sl 1 pwise wyif. (2 sts increased, tot 5 sts on needle)

Row 4: K4, sl1.

Row 5: K1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, sl1.

Row 6: K to last st, sl1.

Repeat rows 5-6 6 more times = 19 sts. Cut yarn and change to color C.

Note! Always cut yarn when change color.

With color C work rows 5-6 a total of 2 times. = 23 sts.

With color B work rows 5-6 a total of 9 times. = 41 sts.

With color C work rows 5-6 a total of 2 times. = 45 sts.

With color A work rows 5-6 a total of 9 times. = 63 sts.

With color C work rows 5-6 a total of 2 times. = 67 sts.

With color B work rows 5-6 a total of 9 times. = 85 sts.

With color C work rows 5-6 a total of 2 times. = 89 sts.

With color A work rows 5-6 a total of 5 times. = **99 sts.** Don't cut the yarn.

Middle part of the shawl

Row 1: K1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, sl1.

Row 2: Knit, sl 1.

Repeat rows 1-2 three more times, cut yarn.

Continue this way repeating rows 1-2, and working stripe sequence as earlier:

Rows 1- 4: Work with color C.

Rows 5 - 22: Work with color B.

Rows 23 - 26: Work with color C.

Rows 27 - 44: Work with color A.

When your work has 11 stripes of color C, 6 stripes from color A and 5 stripes with color B (from the CO edge), start the wide panel:

Row 1 (with color B): K1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, sl1.

Row 2: Knit.

Repeat rows 1-2 2 more times. Do not cut color B.

Row 7 (with color C): K1, kfb, k2, [bobble, k7], repeat [-] to last 7 sts, bobble, k3, k2tog, sl1.

Row 8 (with color C): Knit. Do not cut color C.

Repeat rows 1 - 8 4 more times. Then work rows 1- 6 once more.

Continue with the stripe sequence until you've worked stripes C, A, C, B, C once. Then work with color A 10 rows total as in the pattern. Start decreases.

Row 1: K1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, sl1.

Row 2: Knit.

Repeat rows 1-2 continuing with stripe sequence until you have 3 sts left. Knit 1 row. Sl1, k2tog, slip slipped st over. Cut yarn and pull through the remaining st.

Triangles

With color B and RS facing, pick up and knit 61 sts. Knit 3 rows, slipping the last st on each row as previous.

Row 1: K1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, sl1.

Rows 2 - 4: Knit.

Repeat rows 1- 4 until you have 3 sts left. Knit 1 row. Sl1, k2tog, slip slipped st over. Cut yarn and pull through the remaining st.

Work similar triangle at the other end of the shawl.

Starting at the point of the triangle, work i-cord edge.

I-cord edge (optional)

Note! Knit i-cord really loosely, with 0,5 mm bigger needles if needed!

Using color A, CO 3 sts. [Slip sts back to left needle. K2, sl1 knitwise and knit it together with the next st from edge of the shawl from every slipped row], repeat [-] until you have finished the i-cord edge around the shawl. I knitted only one leg from the slipped stitch, that way the edge looked nicer and smoother. To get the top of the triangles sharp, knit i-cord to the same stitch 2-3 times at the sharpest part. Cut yarn and weave in ends. Make tassels or pompoms and attach those at the points of triangles. Wash the shawl and block to measurements.

ABBREVIATIONS

k	knit
p	purl
sl	slip
s(ts)	stitch(es)
k2tog	knit 2 sts together (= right leaning decrease)
ssk	slip, slip, knit together (=left leaning decrease)
kfb	knit to front and back of the st (increasing 1 st)
RS	right side
WS	wrong side
